WHAT IS IYC?

International Youth Convention is a gathering of 5000+ students from Church of God congregations around the world. The convention is held every other year in various cities around the US, and brings together top-notch worship leaders and speakers to create an opportunity for LIFE CHANGE. Throughout the four days of the convention, students participate in large-group worship, attend relevant conferences, have opportunities to develop leadership skills, and spend time serving the community in which the convention is held. These shared experiences strengthen relationships among students and leaders and make an impact that can last a lifetime! And of course, there's also time for sightseeing and plenty of shenanigans!

WHO CAN GO?

IYC is geared toward students who have completed 7th-12th grades. We require one adult chaperone for every 3 students who attend, but we will take as many parents/other adults as are interested!

WHAT'S THE SCHEDULE?

This year's IYC will be held in Indianapolis, IN July 2-5, 2018. Because of its proximity, we have a unique opportunity to offer a shorter trip at around half the normal cost of an IYC trip. Our current plan is to drive to Indianapolis the morning of July 2 and return either July 5 or 6, depending on whether we decide to add a day of sightseeing. The convention schedule is attached.

HOW MUCH DOES IT COST?

That depends! Convention registration is \$130 if you are registered by January 24th, and the cost increases incrementally as the date gets closer. We are currently looking at 3 options for our itinerary, which will impact the total cost of the trip:

Option A: Convention only (travel dates July 2-5)	\$375.00
Option B: Add a day at the Indianapolis Zoo (travel dates July 2-6)	\$460.00
Option C: ½ day at the zoo (travel dates July 2-5)	\$400.00

The above costs include convention registration at the early-bird rate, plus hotel, food, transportation, parking and zoo tickets (if applicable).
